1 Decide on a Clothing Collection Drive!

Host a targeted drive, focusing on high need items or by focusing on a type of item, such as sneakers, women's clothing, or accessories. Confirm with Skylar Fox prior to deciding what you want to tackle!

2 Create a Flyer!

3 Spread the Word!

Get your community involved by using the email and social media templates to share about your Mitzvah Project. The more the merrier!

4 Host a Clothing Sort!

5 Coordinate with OCIYN Staff!

After your at-home sort, reach out to Skylar Fox to schedule a drop off at the OCIYN Warehouse.

6 Attend an OCIYN Pop-Up!

Connect with Carlee Pons to volunteer at a pop-up shop to experience OCIYN services from start to finish.
